Dear Dr. Bhatt

As I am sure you know the Secretary of State has announced the formation of two new NHS Trusts with effect from 1st April 1994 - the Chelsea and Westminster Healthcare NHS Trust and the Hammersmith Hospitals NHS Trust; the latter comprising the Charing Cross, Hammersmith, Queen Charlotte's and Acton Hospitals.

As a member of the staff of Charing Cross and Westminster Medical School you currently hold an honorary clinical contract which enables you to work within Riverside Hospitals. As from 1st April 1994 this will automatically be transferred to:

The Chelsea and Westminster Healthcare NHS Trust  
allowing you access to patients at Chelsea and  
Westminster Hospital

~~and The Hammersmith Hospitals NHS Trust allowing you  
access to patients at Charing Cross Hospital (and,  
by arrangement, at the other Hospitals within the  
Trust)~~

The terms and conditions of your honorary contract remain otherwise unchanged.

The trade unions and professional bodies are being consulted on the transfer to Trust status, but you may have personal concerns or questions which you wish to discuss. If this is the case, please discuss them first with your Medical School Head of Department or Mr J L Bowen, the Director of Administrative Services and Personnel at the Medical School.
