


Extract from letter to the General Medical Council 10th February 2003.

The following is an extract from the letter sent to the General Medical Council on the 10th February 2003, by Dr John Collins Medical Director Chelsea and Westminster Hospital and Professor Sir Leszek Borysiewicz Non Executive Director and head of Imperial College School of Medicine. The letter has a number of redacted areas; it was obtained from court papers. The extract refers to a number of investigations that were taking place at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital; it has to be pointed out here that these investigations were for no other reason than to harass the consultant neurologist to get rid of Tess from the hospital. These investigations were never completed and the General Medical Council found that the Neurologist had no case to answer.

Extract:

“We believe that as clinicians on the Trust Board, we have to express our concern at the way in which clinical care has been provided for this child, and whether in addition to the other investigations that are taking place, the GMC would wish, to be formally notified of these problems. At this stage there are a number of investigations taking place, and it may be appropriate to await the results of these, but we would value your guidance in this matter.
